 will is that she shall have thys land byn and a Bull or alls Churche parsonage of myny wyf
 she shall have, Item I geve and bequeath unto John my sonne Twenty pound in money or goodes Item
 I geve and bequeath unto Johne my daughter Twenty pound in money or goodes. Item I geve and bequeath
 unto willm my sonne Twenty pound in money or goodes Item I geve and bequeath unto my two sonnes
 John and willm as followeth. Firste to willm my sonne my beste garret and my beste Coate
 Item I geve and bequeath to John my sonne my seconde Garret and my Batten Doublet. The residue
 of my apparell to be divided indifferently betwix them. Item I will that margaret my wyf
 shal be Custodye of my Cochet of silver being gilted wryng twenty ounces so longe as she liveth
 and after her decease I geve it to willm my sonne. Item I geve and bequeath my brother Richarde
 two sonnes Thomas and John Exor Challunge Dughe to have a pore. Item I geve and bequeath the
 residue of my goodes to bequeste my debtes being paid and my funerally discharged to be indifferently
 divided betwix margaret my wyf and John my sonne willm my sonne and John my daughter
 at the discretion of my overseers Except such beddinge and Marryng ware or lymyns wch they buye
 and shal be wch my wyf had possessid of before I married her that I will she shall have
 at her discretion And unto the execution of this my last will and testament I ordaine to substitute
 and appointe Margaret my wyf and willm both my sonne my exors to see this my last
 will and Testament performed. Item I ordaine to substitute and appointe willm my sonne
 and Richarde Powell gent overseers unto this my last will and Testament. In witness wherof
 I have hereunto putt my hande and Seale the daye and yere above written. This beinge
 witness wherof names are here subscribed, Richarde Powell merchant Thomas Cylter Richarde
 both glouer Thomas Cotte John hple glouer, Edmunde beuf clerk

In da nomine Amen I John Bobbet of Blaxsalle in the Countie of Suffolke and Justice
 of peace beinge by godly sufferance and grace sike in bodye but of good and perfect remembrance
 blessed be god therfore, the Twentieth daye of December in the yere of our Lorde God 1576 and
 in the yere of the reigne of our most dread sovereigne ladye Elizabeth by the Grace of God
 of Englande, France and Irelande Queene Defender of the faith etc the Twentieth daye of December
 I have made this my last will and Testament wherby I doe will and bequeath unto all
 myne goods and Chattels by me hereunto made in manner and forme followinge. Firste I doe
 geve and bequeath my soule unto god the most blessed and holye Trinity father sonne
 and the holle goste whome I most humbly beseech to receive my soule into the state of hevenlye
 and Everlastinge blisses, and in the said state to continue forever. And my bodye I doe bequeath
 unto the churche from whence I came willinge my Exors to cause the same to be buried wch the church
 of Blaxsalle afore said in the accustomed place appointed for the buriall of the Deade in such
 decent maner as they shall thinke beste. Item I geve to the poore of the parische of Little Cleeve
 Twenty shillings to be paid immediatly after my decease. Item I geve to the poore of the Towne of
 Mistale two pound to be paid wch one yere after my decease. I geve unto the poore of the Towne of
 Cote Shillings to be paid one yere after my decease. Item I geve to the poore of the Towne of

florid so many hogges so much the same and w^{ch} loads of hay so many plowes and harrows or the worth of
them as is before given I am I give to Cecylie my wife w^{ch} m^{ch} the great w^{ch} w^{ch} to be taken
out of the m^{ch} I am I give to her by my w^{ch} w^{ch} and out two young bull in the m^{ch} I am
I give to her my w^{ch} w^{ch} and my blacke getinge. I am I give to Cecylie my wife my lease of my house
of Blayfalle during the terme of her life, and all the Cornes in the Barne and Colles at Blayfalle
and Ellubyn, and all my tenur upon the grounde in Blayfalle. I am I give to Cecylie my wife three
p^{ch} of all my movable. I am I will that Cecylie my wife or her ex^{ch} shall paye unto my
ex^{ch} after her decease former p^{ch} and Tenur Combes of gr^{ch}, that is to say Combes
of w^{ch}, w^{ch} Combes of By, and w^{ch} Combes of W^{ch}. I am I give to Cecylie my wife Tenur
of w^{ch} spoons, w^{ch} of the best nor of the worst, and the rest to my ex^{ch}. I am I
give the said Cecylie my wife the Combes of By out of my Cornes at Alborough. I am I give unto
Thomas Wrighte the sonne of a p^{ch} to be paid to him at the age of w^{ch} years. I am I give to
John Wrighte the sonne of Robert Wrighte to be paid at the age of w^{ch} years. I am I give to
Esbornes the sonne of the said w^{ch} to be paid to him at the age of w^{ch} years. I am I will that
all the leg^{ch} bequestes and giftes bequested and given by the will of William Palmer w^{ch} I stande
charged to paye, the one half as by the said will is mentio^{ch}, and John Wrighte the other half to be
paid and discharged by my ex^{ch}. I am I give to Mr^{ch} Fran^{ch} Sum^{ch} the elder Tenur
p^{ch} of the w^{ch} w^{ch} he ow^{ch} me for to be my super^{ch} of this my laste will and testam^{ch}
of my w^{ch} all my w^{ch} to stande good M^{ch} unto my wife and to my ex^{ch} as by the
w^{ch} done to me. I am I give to Mr^{ch} Ellen Sum^{ch} daughter of the said Fran^{ch} w^{ch}

I am I give to Mr^{ch} Fran^{ch} Sum^{ch} the younger to be paid out of the said w^{ch}. I am I give unto Mr^{ch} Ab^{ch}
Sum^{ch} to be paid likewise out of the said w^{ch}. I am I give the w^{ch} of the said w^{ch}
p^{ch} w^{ch} is p^{ch} unto Mr^{ch} Sum^{ch} and to Mr^{ch} Ellen the sister to be equally divided between them
I am I give unto Mr^{ch} Sum^{ch} my libell gette w^{ch} that is in the m^{ch}. I am I give unto William
Pallmer w^{ch} to be paid w^{ch} one year after my decease. I am I give to Peter Esbornes w^{ch} to be
paid w^{ch} after my decease. I am I give to John Barber w^{ch} to be paid w^{ch} after my
decease. I am I give to Margery Martin w^{ch} to be paid w^{ch} after my decease. I am I give
to Margery Starlett w^{ch} to be paid w^{ch} after my decease. I am I will that my leg^{ch}
giftes and bequestes given and bequested by the will of William Louge of Rofford w^{ch} are to be discharged
by me John Bobbett, be discharged by my ex^{ch} and every thing therein contained. I am I will that
my M^{ch} Fran^{ch} Sum^{ch} shall have the lease of my house after the decease of Cecylie my
wife upon Condition that he the said M^{ch} Fran^{ch} Sum^{ch} do give and paye unto my ex^{ch}
so much the money as is paid for the w^{ch} of the same as is mentio^{ch} in a p^{ch} of Indentures
made between the said M^{ch} Fran^{ch} and me, the w^{ch} spent of the same lease to be repaid
And I will that Edward Louge eldest sonne of the said William shall have all my ground lying
in w^{ch} called Starles w^{ch} I bought of Mr^{ch} Ellen Sum^{ch} to him and to his heirs after he
shall accomplish the age of w^{ch} years in recompense of the w^{ch} to him given by the laste
will of his father, And if the said Edward will not take that in this sorte then I will that
my ex^{ch} or the survivor of them shall see all my said lands called Starles, and shall the
meadowes thereof to paye the said w^{ch}. And in the mean tyme I will that my ex^{ch}
shall take the profits of the same ground towards the w^{ch} of this my will, All the rest
of my good Chatter and debts bequested I committe them to the Disposition of my ex^{ch} to
the w^{ch} of this my said will. I am I ordene and make my ex^{ch} of this my laste will
and testam^{ch} Thomas Esbornes of Emstall, Edmonde Smythe of Chatefeldes Robert
Smythe of W^{ch} Taylor, William my ex^{ch} to laye in bond to my M^{ch} my super^{ch} in the
summe of three hundred pounds, that is to say one hundred pounds a p^{ch}, for the true and
faithfull execution of this my laste will and testam^{ch}, and every thing therein contained, And of
