 40 Enter the same by such time as he shall be  
 at the age of our and twenty years Item  
 I will and give unto my daughter Dorothy

 to be payd her by my sonne John out of  
 my Landes at such time as he shall come  
 to the age of our and twenty years  
 Item I give to Dorothy out good Milles to be  
 50 to be solided unto her within the comety  
 to the age of sixtene years by the hande  
 of my Executor Item I give & bequeath  
 unto Alice my daughter the sume of fyve  
 poundes of good and Lawfull money to be
